A. Count Day Report - Our official/unofficial count on the fall count day was 886.6 students. This is an increase of 41.6 students over the 845 that we budgeted for. Last year our actual count in the fall was 842.08. We received state aid on 867.1 students because the state used a three year blended count as a result of declining enrollment.

- B. Bond Update There are still things that need to be done or to be done over. We will have a steering committee meeting on November 29th to discuss and resolve remaining issues.
- C. Administrator Evaluation Training Karen Pylman completed the Superintendent Evaluation Training on October 25, 2017. Now all board members have been trained on the evaluation tool that is used to evaluate the Superintendent.
- D. MSP Audit We recently had a compliance audit regarding noncriminal justice agency use of criminal justice information. We are now in complete compliance with all the current regulations.
- E. JAZZ Band Some interest by students has been expressed to establish a JAZZ Band. It was suggested if interest remains that it be considered for the 2018-19 school year. The director position would need to be posted as it is a Schedule B position.
